ALWAYS

- USE MATCHES SAFELY AND CAREFULLY!
- STORE FIRE-MAKING MATERIALS IN A SAFE, PROTECTED PLACE!
- HAVE AN AREA TEN FEET IN DIAMETER CLEARED OF ANY BURNABLE MATERIAL, WHEN MAKING A FIRE!
- KEEP YOUR FIRE JUST LARGE ENOUGH TO DO THE JOB!
- HAVE AT LEAST ONE FILLED WATER **BUCKET NEARBY!**
- HAVE A SHOVEL NEARBY!
- TAKE PRECAUTIONS TO KEEP THE FIRE CONTAINED BY SURROUNDING THE FIRE LAY WITH NON-POROUS ROCKS, LARGE LOGS, OR MINERAL SOIL!
- BURN GARBAGE SENSIBLY, (IF YOU ARE **BURNING GARBAGE AT ALL)!**
- MAKE SURE A FIRE IS COLD-OUT BEFORE LEAVING!
- USE STOVES WITH CARE, REPORTING ANY MALFUNCTION IMMEDIATELY TO AN ADUI TI

NEVER

- EVER PLAY WITH MATCHES!
- LIGHT A MATCH. . . EXCEPT WHEN NEEDED!
- USE A LIGHTER ON A CAMPING TRIP **EXCEPT WHEN NECESSARY!**
- LIGHT A FIRE IN AN AREA NEAR MATERIAL THAT CAN BURN!
- BUILD A FIRE LARGER THAN THE SIZE YOU NEED TO COOK OR TO WARM!
- PUT UNNECESSARY TINDER OR KINDLING INTO A LIVE FIRE!
- IN NORMAL CIRCUMSTANCES, HOLD OR CARRY ANYTHING ON FIRE!
- USE ANY CHEMICALS IN OR NEAR A
- BURN ANYTHING THAT IS UNDER PRESSURE!
- LEAVE A FIRE UNATTENDED!
- LIGHT A STOVE THAT HAS A LEAK OR THAT HAS BUILT UP TOO MUCH PRESSURE!
- PLAY WITH, OR HORSEPLAY AROUND, FIRE!!!
